Pavillion 14 is located just off Bradys Run Road, the main drive through the park.

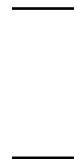
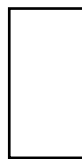
Your club will supply hamburgers, hotdogs, buns and fixin's along with a grill
